**Commercial Circular (Coaching) No.31/2021**

**Rate advice No.10 of 2021**

**(Amendment no.13 to Comprehensive Parcel Leasing Policy)**

विषय/Sub: Amendment to 'Comprehensive Parcel Leasing Policy' – Successful Bidder's inability to commence the contract.

संदर्भ/Ref: Railway Board letter No.2021/TC(FM\_)/10/09 dated 04-10-2021.

**(Freight Marketing Circular No.22 of 2021)**

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Attention is invited to Para 20.0 of the CPLP (issued vide Board's FM Circular No. 06/2014, dated 15-04-2021) which stipulates procedure for dealing cases related to **failure of lease holder to start or operate lease contract**.

1. The matter has been deliberated upon, and with a view to liberalize the Policy and to accommodate the problems being faced by lease-holders during situations such as lock-down etc—it has been decided to modify the sub-para **20.1**, by adding a provision as under:

*"20.1 on allotment of contract, the successful bidder (leaseholder) shall be required to commence the loading within a period of 15 days, failing which the contract will be terminated and Earnest money/ security deposit will be forfeited.*

*The accepting authority shall be empowered to condone the delay on the merits of the case on written application from leaseholder and give another 15 days (maximum period) to the leaseholder for commencement of contract.*

***However, in cases when the successful bidder has not been able to start or operate the lease contract within the maximum time period (including the condoned period of delay, if any)- due to circumstances beyond his control (such as curfew, lockdown, natural calamity etc.) he may prefer an appeal - within 15 days of normalization of the situation- to allow him to start or operate the lease contract. On receipt of such appeal, PCCM of the Zonal Railway (on recommendation of the Division) may grant relaxation in the period for commencing the contract, up a maximum of 30 days, duly considering the merit of case."***

2. These instructions shall come into force with immediate effect.
3. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
