3. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION: Pass in Matriculation or ITI or its equivalent from a recognized board.

NOTE: Persons if appointed to the category of Clerk-cum-Typist should acquire Typing proficiency of 30 w.p.m. in English or 25 w.p.m. in Hindi within a period of four years from the date of appointment and till such time their appointments to this category will be provisional.

4. AGE: 18 - 25 years as on 01.01.2012. No age relaxation is permissible.

5. SPORTS NORMS FOR RECRUITMENT:

5.1 Sports persons desirous of applying for the posts in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2400/2800 of the above against any of the Games as mentioned in the above table should have:

(i) Represented the country in Olympic Games(Senior Category).

OR

(ii) Obtained at least 3rd position in the International championships/events in either World Cup(Junior/Senior Category) or World Championships (Junior/Senior Category) or Asian Games (Senior Category) or Commonwealth Games (Senior Category).

5.2 Sportspersons desirous of applying for the posts in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.1900/2000 of the above against any of the Games as mentioned in the above table should have:

(i) Represented the country in the International championships/events in either World Cup(Junior/Senior Category) or World Championships (Junior/Senior Category) or Asian Games (Senior Category) or Commonwealth Games (Senior Category).

OR

(ii) Obtained at least 3rd position in either Commonwealth Games (Junior/Senior Category) or Asian Championships/Asia Cup(Junior/Senior Category) or South Asian Federation Games (Senior Category) or USIC Championships(Senior Category).

OR

(iii) Obtained at least 3rd position in Senior/Youth/Junior National Championships.

OR

(iv) Obtained at least 3rd position in National Games organized under aegis of Indian Olympic Association.

OR

(v) Obtained at least 3rd position in All India Inter University Championship organized under the aegis of Association of Indian Universities.

OR

(vi) Obtained 1st position in Federation Cup Championships (Senior Category).

5.3 Sportspersons desirous of applying for the posts in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.1800 (erstwhile Gr.'D' posts) of the above against any of the Games as mentioned in the above table should have:

(i) Represented the country in Championship in either Commonwealth Championships (Junior/Senior Category) or Asian Championships (Junior/Senior Category) or South Asian Federation Games (Senior Category) or USIC Championships (Senior Category).

OR

(ii) Obtained at least 3rd position in Federation Cup Championships (Senior Category).

OR

(iii) Represented State or equivalent Unit, except in Marathon and Cross Country in Senior/Youth/Junior National Championship.

OR

(iv) Obtained at least 3rd position in Senior State Championships for all units and Districts of the state.

Note:

(a) In Athletics, medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Athletics Championships will also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs.1900 in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200.

(b) In Cricket at International level, representation of Main Indian Seniors Team in a Test Match or in a Limited Overs One Day International Match or in a Twenty-20 Overs Match, are eligible for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs.1900/2000 in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200.

(c) In Cricket at National Level, following sports achievements in 4Days/One Day Limited Overs/Twenty-20 Overs Championships(except Vizzy Trophy); organized under the aegis of BCCI, will also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs.1800 or 1900 in PB-1 Rs.5200-20200:

(d) In Chess, following sports achievements will also be considered for recruitment in different Grade pay and Pay Bands listed below:

(e) All the championships mentioned above should have been conducted under the aegies of recognized International/National/State Sports Federation and also recognized by Railway Sports Promotion Board.

(f) For the norms mentioned under 5.1(iii) and 5.2(iii) above, only senior National and Junior National Championships shall be taken into consideration. **National Games, Rural meets, Festival meets and other similar tournaments shall not be considered.**

6. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:

The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. **Therefore, the sports achievements of on or after 01.04.2009 are only considered.**

7. HOW TO APPLY:

Application as per the format given below shall be submitted on A-4 size good quality paper. **The application format should be in English or Hindi language only and should be filled in English or Hindi only. The applications submitted in other than English or Hindi languages will be summarily rejected.** The application should be filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting and signed. The candidate has to affix one recent passport size photograph duly attested by a Gazetted Officer with office seal on the application in the space provided for the purpose. Candidate is also advised to attach one extra passport size photograph along with the application.

8. EXAMINATION FEE:

(a) The examination fee for Unreserved and OBC candidates is Rs.40/-. The examination fee should be paid in the form of Indian Postal Order from any Post office or demand draft from any Nationalize Bank drawn in favour of and payable at as follows:

In respect of HQrs quota post: **FA & CAO, South Western Railway, Hubli and payable at Hubli.**

In respect of Hubli Division quota post: Sr.DFM, Hubli & payable at Hubli.

In respect of Bangalore Division quota post: Sr.DFM, Bangalore & payable at Bangalore.

In respect of Mysore Division quota post: Sr.DFM, Mysore & payable at Mysore.

(b) Remittance of examination fee in any other form except Demand Draft/Indian Postal Order will not be accepted.

(c) IPOs/DDs issued before the date of issue of Employment notice or after the closing date will not be accepted and the application will be rejected.

(d) The particulars of Bank Draft/Indian Postal Order submitted as examination fee should also be indicated at the prescribed place in the application form.

(e) Candidates must write their name, full address at the space provided in the Indian Postal Order/Demand Draft.

(f) The examination fee is not refundable/transferable/adjustable under any circumstances.

9. FEE EXEMPTIONS: SC/ST candidates, Ex-Servicemen, Women candidates, Minority candidates*, and candidates belonging to Economically Backward Classes** are exempted from payment of examination fees.

*** Minorities mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists and Zoroastrians (Parsis). ** Economically Backward Classes will mean the candidates whose family income is less than Rs.50,000 per annum.**

The following authorities are authorized to issue income certificate for the purpose of identifying economically backward classes: (i) District magistrate or any other revenue officer up to the level of Tehsildar. (ii) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency. (iii) BPL card or any other certificate issued by the central government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.(iv) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from any where in the country (v) Sitting members of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside. The income certificate issued by the authorities mentioned above would have to be on Format-A which is enclosed herewith. This would have to be issued on the letter head of the issuing authority.

10. WHOM TO APPLY:

Application complete in all respects should be sent in a cover addressed as follow:

In respect of HQrs quota: Senior Personnel Officer/E, Personnel department, South Western Railway Headquarters, 1st Floor, Zonal Headquarters Building, Opposite to Rail Nagar, Gadag Road, Hubli-580 020.

In respect of Hubli Division quota posts: Sr. Divisional Personnel officer, DRM's Office Compound, Personnel Branch, S.W.Railway, Hubli Division, Hubli-580 020.

In respect of Bangalore Division quota posts: Sr. Divisional Personnel officer, DRM's Office Complex, 2nd Floor, Personnel Branch, S.W.Railway, Bangalore Division, Bangalore-560 023.

In respect of Mysore Division quota posts: Sr. Divisional Personnel officer, DRM's Office complex, Personnel, S.W.Railway, Irwin Road, Mysore-570021.

NOTE: The applications should reach on or before 08.11.2011. For candidates residing in Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Jammu & Kashmir, Lahaul & Spiti districts and Pangi sub-division of Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman, Nicobar and Lakshadweep islands and the candidates residing abroad, the closing date for receipt of applications by post will be **23.11.2011**.

The cover containing the application should be super-scribed as any of the following depending upon the unit (HQrs/Division) for which the candidate is applying.

11. RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

The recruitment will be based on trials, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates **who are found fit** in trials only will be considered for next stage.

12. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (a) Before applying to the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility norms.
- (b) The name and initial of the candidate and father's name appearing in school/college certificates and in sports certificates should be one and the same. **There should be no difference.**
- (c) The specific position (100/200 Mtrs.run/100 Mtrs.Hurdles/110 Mtrs. Hurdles/400 Mtrs.run/80/1500 Mtrs. Run/5000/10000 Mtrs. Run/3000 Mtrs. Steeple Chase/ All-rounder/ Opening Batsman/ Left Arm Spinner/medium Pace bowler/70 Kg/56 Kg/ 77 Kg/ 94 Kg/105 Kg/Back Stoke/ Long Distance free style 800/1500 Mtrs./Attacker/blocker) played in the particular game/event if applicable should be mentioned in the application without fail.

- (d) The candidates already employed in Central/States/PSUs including Railways should submit their applications through proper channel duly submitting "no objection certificate" from their employer.
- (e) The decision of the Railway Administration in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, penalty for false information, and mode of selection shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- (f) Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prescribed for the selected post.
- (g) Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
- (h) The candidates should be in readiness to appear for the trials at short notice after the last date for receipt of applications is over.

13. ENCLOSURES:

The following enclosures should be firmly attached along with the completed application form. **(If the certificates are in a language other than English/Hindi, attested translation in English/Hindi should also be enclosed)**

- (i) Attested copy of certificate in proof of academic qualification.
- (ii) Attested copy of Certificate in proof of Date of Birth.
- (iii) Attested copies of Certificates in proof of Sports qualifications/achievements as mentioned under qualification above.
- (iv) Attested copy of Latest community certificate issued by competent authority if he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC.
- (v) Crossed Indian Postal Orders/Demand draft as indicated at Para No.8
- (vi) One extra passport size photograph.

14. INVALID APPLICATIONS:

Applications with the following lacunae and irregularities will be summarily rejected.

- i. Applications which are incomplete, unsigned and which are not in prescribed format.
- ii. Applications which are not in English/Hindi language.
- iii. Applications without attested copies of certificates in proof of age, educational qualification etc.
- iv. Enclosed attested copies of certificates which are not in English/Hindi language (or enclosures not translated to English/Hindi if the certificates are in languages other than English/Hindi).
- v. Applications without examination fee in the form of Indian Postal Order/Demand draft (wherever applicable).
- vi. Applications without attested photographs affixed.
- vii. Applications received after closing date.
