INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES:

The applicant has to fulfill the following conditions:-

1. Age: 18 – 33 years as on 01.01.2011

Extent of Age Relaxation:

Serving Railway employees who have put in a minimum of 3 years of service will be given relaxation of age to the extent of service rendered, subject to the upper age limit not exceeding 40 years.

2. Essential Qualifications:

a. Educational Qualifications:

10th Standard passed (Matriculation) or ITI or its equivalent

b. Scouts & Guides Qualifications:

- i. A President's Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger (or) Himalayan Wood Badge Holder (or) a pre-Himalayan Wood Badge trained Scout Leader/Advanced Trained Guide Leader
- ii. Should have been an active member of Scouts Organization for at least 3 years in the recent past and should continue to be active
- iii. Should have attended at least one event at National level and one or two events at State level (or) should have a good record of participation in Scouts/Guides activities at Unit/District level.

3. How to Apply:

Application as per the format given below shall be submitted on A-4 size good quality paper. **The application format should be in English/Hindi language only and the application should be filled in English/Hindi language only. The application submitted in other than English/Hindi languages will be summarily rejected.** The application should be filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting and signed. The candidate has to affix one recent passport size photograph (recently taken and in scout uniform) duly attested by a Gazetted Officer on the application in the space provided for the purpose. Candidate is also required to attach one extra passport size photograph along with the application.

4. Examination fee:

The Candidates have to send a crossed Indian Postal Order or Bank Demand Draft for Rs.40/- drawn in favour of **Sr. Divisional Finance Manager, Mysore** and payable at Mysore. The candidates belonging to SC/ST community are exempted from payment of examination fees.

5. Whom to Apply:

Application complete in all respect should be sent along with all enclosures in a cover super scribed "Application for Railway Service against Scouts/Guides Quota for the year 2010-2011" and addressed to "**The Senior Divisional Personnel Officer, Divisional Office, South Western Railway, Irvin Road, Near Mysore Railway Station, Mysore – 570 021**". The application should reach the above office on or before 17:00 hrs on 25.04.2011.

6. Recruitment Process:

The recruitment will be based on written test and interview. The candidates, whose applications are found eligible in all respects, will be assessed on the following basis. The eligible candidates will be called for written test and those who qualify in written test will be called for viva-voce.

(A)	The written test will consist of 50 objective type questions relating to Scouts & Guides organization and its activities as per syllabus detailed below	50 Marks
(B)	Scouts/Guides Qualifications over and above the minimum prescribed as eligibility condition	35 Marks
	1. Participation in International Event (one event – 5marks, two or more events – 7 marks)	7 marks
	2. Participation in National Events/National Jamboree (No marks for the first event if the same being the minimum eligibility condition; one additional event – 5marks, two or more additional events – 7 marks)	7 marks
	3. Participation in Indian Railway Jamboree (one event – 5marks, two or more events – 7 marks)	7 marks
	4. Events/Rallies attended at State Level (one event – 5marks, two or more events – 7 marks)	7 marks
	5. Specialized Scout/Guide Courses eg. Pioneering, Mapping, Standard Judging Course/Vocational Craft Course	7 marks
(C)	Personality Test/Interview	15 Marks

(D) Syllabus for the Written Examination will be as under:

History of Scouting/Guiding. Law & Promise; Organisation – District & State Level; Training Centre – District & State Level; Knowledge of Books – Scouting for Boys, Girl Guiding in India, Motto, left hand shake, Salute, Prayer, Flag Song, National Anthem, Know the National and Scouting flags, Social services at various occasions, Hiking, Proficiency Badges, How these are earned? Stages in Scouting/Guiding, Thinking Day, Progressive Training of Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Rangers, Pioneering, Handicrafts, Indian Railway Jamboree, National Jamborees, Jamboree on Air. Organisation at National Level: National Training Centres, WAGGGS/WOSM – Rashtrapathi Award Competition; Prime Minister Shield Competition; Community Development Programmes; Aims and methods of Scouting; How Scouting is useful in producing better citizens?

7. General Conditions:

- a. Before applying to the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility norms.
- b. The candidates already employed in Central/State PSUs should submit their applications through proper channel duly submitting service certificate and no objection certificate from the employer.
- c. The decision of the Railway Administration in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, penalty for false information, mode of selection shall be final and binding on the candidate.
- d. Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prescribed for the selected post.
- e. Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
- f. The candidates should be in readiness to appear for the written test at short notice after the last date is over.

8. Enclosures:

The following enclosures should be firmly attached along with the completed application form. *(If the certificates are in a language other than English/Hindi, attested translation in English/Hindi should also be enclosed)*

- a. Attested copy of Certificate in proof of academic qualification and experience.

- c. Attested copy of Certificate in proof of Scouts/Guides activities as mentioned under qualification above.
- d. Attested copy of latest Community Certificate issued by competent authority if he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC.
- e. Crossed Indian Postal Order or Bank Demand Draft as indicated at item No.4 .
- f. Extra Passport size photograph (Recently Taken)

9. Invalid Applications:

Applications with the following lacunae and irregularities will be summarily rejected.

- i. Applications which are incomplete, unsigned and which are not in prescribed format.
- ii. Applications which are not in English/Hindi language.
- iii. Applications without attested copies of certificates in proof of age, qualification, community etc.
- iv. Enclosed attested copies of certificates which are not in English/Hindi language (or enclosures not translated to English/Hindi if the certificates are in other than English/Hindi language)
- v. Applications without examination fee. (Indian Postal Orders/Demand draft)
- vi. Applications without attested photographs affixed.
- vii. Applications received after closing date.
