Indian Railways is the lifeline of the nation and catalyst for India's progress and economic development. South Western Railway plays a significant role in the socio-economic development of Karnataka state. The Railway has been operational from 1st April, 2003 with headquarters at Hubballi in the state of Karnataka. Southern & South Central Railways join hands with South Western Railway in contributing towards development of Karnataka and improvement of train services.

Railways have achieved many visible milestones in Karnataka in 3-4 years, 252 Kms of new lines and 212 Kms of doubling have been completed in last 3 years. 92 new Mail/Express and Passenger trains have been introduced. Apart from this, many trains have been extended and frequency increased. On the freight side, loading on South Western Railway has been continuously increased to about 45 million tonnes.

**A. ASSEMBLY SEGMENTS:** Hadagali, Hagaribommanahalli, Vijayanagara, Kampli, Ballari, Ballari City, Sandur, Kudligi.

**B. WORKS COMPLETED IN LAST THREE YEARS:**

**B1. Infrastructural developments:**

- ❖ Limited Height Subways (LHS) have been constructed in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No.01, 18 and 27 between Ballari-Rayadurg section, in lieu of LC No. 09 between Toranagallu –Ranjitpura section and in lieu of LC No. 91 and 92 between Hosapete-Ballari Section at a total cost of Rs. 06 Crore.

**B2. Passenger Amenities**

- ❖ Improvement work of Circulating area has been done at Toranagallu station at a cost of Rs. 10 Lakh.
- ❖ To improve cleanliness, 20 Nos. of stainless steel dustbins have been provided at Ballari station at a cost of Rs. 1 Lakh.
- ❖ Signages at Toranagallu station has been provided to guide the passengers at a cost of Rs. 5 Lakh.
- ❖ Platform shelter provided and extended at Gadiganuru at a cost of Rs. 50 Lakh.
- ❖ Platform shelters have been provided at Toranagallu, Kudatini, Daroji stations at a total cost of Rs. 75 Lakh.
- ❖ Additional seating arrangements have been provided at Ballari, Ballari Cantonment, Kudatini and Hosapete stations at a total cost of Rs. 26 Lakh.
- ❖ Waiting Hall of Ballari station has been renovated at a cost of Rs. 6 Lakh.
- ❖ For ease of ticketing, Automatic Ticket Vending Machines (ATVMs) have been provided at Ballari (04 Nos.) and Hosapete (04 Nos.) railway stations.
- ❖ Railway reservation facility has been provided at Ballari city post office.
- ❖ Booking facility at Ballari railway station has been improved at a cost of Rs. 2 Lakh.
- ❖ At Toranagallu, Separate Booking counter has been provided for Divyangs.
- ❖ New Toilet block has been constructed at Ballari, Kudatini at a total cost of Rs. 18 Lakh.
- ❖ Toilet and drinking water facility has been provided for Divyangs at Toranagallu Station at a cost of Rs. 4 Lakh.
- ❖ New Coach guidance display boards are provided at Toranagallu Station at a cost of Rs. 48 Lakh.
- ❖ To enhance Security, 7 Nos. of CCTV Cameras at Ballari station and 6 Nos. of CCTV Cameras at Hosapete station have been installed at a cost of Rs. 23 lakh and Rs. 20 Lakh respectively.

**C. OTHERS:**

- ❖ Train No. 57477/78, Tirupati-Rayadurg-Tirupati Daily Passenger has been introduced for benefit of public.
- ❖ Stoppage of Train No.16217/18 Mysuru- Sainagar Shirdi - Mysuru Weekly express has been provided at Ballari and Hosapete railway stations.
- ❖ Stoppage of Train No. 18111/12, Tatanagar-Baiyyappanahalli-Tatanagar Weekly Express has been provided at Ballari railway station.
- ❖ Stoppage of Train No. 82653/54, Yesvantpur-Jaipur-Yesvantpur Weekly Suvidha Express has been provided at Ballari railway station.
- ❖ Stoppage of Train No. 16229/30, Mysuru-Varanasi-Mysuru Bi-Weekly Express has been provided at Ballari railway station.
- ❖ Train No. 57477/78, Tirupati-Rayadurg-Tirupati Daily Passenger has been extended from Rayadurg to Kadirideverapalli for benefit of public.

**D. ONGOING WORKS:**

- ❖ Electrification and doubling between Hosapete and Ballari including Toranagallu and Ranjitpura Branch line is in progress.
- ❖ Work is going on for provision of escalator at Ballari and Toranagallu Station.
- ❖ Additional Foot Over Bridge work at Ballari Station is in progress.
- ❖ Hosapete station is being developed jointly with Ministry of Tourism with all facilities.
- ❖ Road Over Bridges are being constructed in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No. 111 between Ballari and Ballari Cantonment, in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No.102 near Kudatini, in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No. 10 between Hosapete and Tungabhadra Dam, in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No. 85 between Hosapete and Kariganuru, in lieu of Level Crossing Gate No.114 between Ballari and Haddinagundu.
