**The above mutual transfer is ordered subject to the following terms and conditions as detailed below:**

1. The employee will take his/her seniority in the new seniority units to which they are transferred as per extant rules applicable for such mutual transfer ie., either they will retain their own seniority or take the seniority of the railway servant with whom they sought mutual transfer, whichever is lowest.
2. As per RBE 08/2019 both the employees should be spared immediately within a week without either unit waiting for reliever.
3. They will not seek re-transfer to his parent unit/division at a later date.
4. They are not eligible for any benefits on transfer account as the transfer is ordered on his own request.
5. There is no DAR/SPE/Vig. Cases pending/contemplated against Shri Avinash A H.
6. He will be prepared to work anywhere in the new division to which he is transferred.
7. If he is occupation of railway quarters, he should vacate the same before being relieved and should hand over all the railway materials/property if any, under their possession to his immediate Supervisor before relief.
8. He is hereby advised that in terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)I-2006/TR/6 dated 21.4.2006, no request for back tracking from the mutual exchange will be entertained under any circumstances.

While releasing the staff concerned, the following formalities may be complied with, in terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)I-2001/TR/16 dated 21.11.2001.

- a. The releasing Memorandum should have the photograph of the employee pasted on it duly attested in the manner that the signature of the releasing officer and the designation stamp below that appear partially on photograph and partially on paper outside the photograph.
- b. Sparing Memo should have the signature of the transferred employee and his thumb impression both of which should be duly attested by the officer signing the releasing memorandum/order with officer's name and designation appearing below the signature.
