Sub: Re-engagement of Retired employees in MYS
Division, South Western Railway.

Ref: RBE No.150/2017 and RBE No.193/2017

In terms of Railway Board letter No.E(NG)-II/2007/RC-4/CORE/1 dated 16.10.2017 it has been decided to fill up vacancies in the following categories of MYS Division by re-engagement of retired Railway Employees of MYS Division of South Western Railway on monthly remuneration basis to the extent of vacancies notified below.

Therefore applications from retired employees who have retired from Railway service of MYS Division, South Western Railway are called for to reach Sr.DPO/O/MYS.

The re-engagement is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The scheme is valid upto 01.12.2019.
2. Only the employees retired from South Western Railway are eligible to apply.
3. The Re-engagement shall be strictly upto the age of 65 years on or before 31.12.2019 or till the vacancies are filled up by the regularly selected candidates through RRB/RRC/Departmental Selections whichever is earlier.
4. The maximum upper age limit for re-engagement is 65 years. No re-engaged employee should continue in service beyond 65 years of age.
5. The Administration is at liberty to terminate the services of the re-engaged employees even before 01.12.2019 in case their work/conduct is not found satisfactory.
6. The employees who have been Removed/Dismissed/Compulsorily retired as a result of Disciplinary actions or in review are NOT ELIGIBLE for re-engagement.
7. Employees who have retired under LARSGESS/SRRS schemes are also NOT ELIGIBLE.
8. Monthly remuneration of a retired employee being re-engaged be determined by reducing Pension from his/her last pay drawn (i.e. Basic Pay + DA). The re-engaged employees are not entitled any other benefit or facilities except the monthly fixed remuneration as stated above.


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9. The employee who is re-engaged shall execute an agreement to abide by all the terms & conditions of re-engagement.
10. Re-engagement shall be subject to prescribed medical fitness for the category in which they are re-engaged.
11. Suitability/Competency of the applicant shall be adjudged by nominated committee before their re-engagement.
12. The duty hours of the re-engaged employee would be prescribed by the competent authority as per the working conditions of the post.
13. Applicants should enclose copy of any of the following documents along with their application.
 - i.) Service Certificate.
 - ii.) Pensioner Identity Card.
 - iii.) Pension Payment Order.
14. Retired Railway employees, who are desirous for the re-engagement for the posts as mentioned above, should submit their applications in the prescribed format, enclosed herewith along with the documents mentioned above, addressed to Sr.DPO/O/MYS.
15. The employees who will be retiring in September/October-2019 can also apply for the engagement of retired staff.
16. **The last date for receipt of applications in this office is 14/10/2019 upto 18:00 hrs.**
