NOTIFICATION FOR FILLING OF VACANCIES OF JUNIOR ENGINEER(P.WAY), JUNIOR ENGINEER(WORKS), JUNIOR ENGINEER(DRAWING) BY ENGAGEMENT OF JUNIOR TECHNICAL ASSOCIATES ON CONTRACT BASIS

1. Notice:-

South Western Railway, Mysuru Division invites application from Indian Citizens, who fulfill the Technical qualification, and other terms and conditions for engagement as Junior Technical Associates on contractual basis, Civil Engineering Department of South Western Railway, Mysuru Division.

2. Vacancy, Age & Medical Classification:-

Note:-

- No age relaxation is allowed to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying against UR vacancies.
- The number of vacancies indicated in the Notification is provisional and may increase or decrease or even become NIL depending upon the actual needs of the Railway Administration.
- The vacancies are within the geographical jurisdiction of Mysuru Division of South Western Railway
- All candidates, irrespective of community will be considered against UR Vacancies, against the vacancies earmarked for specific (SC/ST/OBC), only candidate belonging to that community/Group will be considered for this purpose SC/ST/OBC candidates should furnish caste certificate from competent authority as per the prescribed format enclosed. They have to upload the self attested copies of SC/ST/OBC certificate.

ii) They will be paid daily allowance when on tour as admissible at the rate of Rs.500/day

6. Period of contract:-

For a period up to 30.11.2020 from the date of engagement or till vacant posts are filled by RRB candidates whichever is earlier.

7. Date/Time/Place of Interview:-

To ensure engagement of candidates with merit and quality minimum percentage of marks has been prescribed for applying to the post in para-3. Meritorious Candidates who have applied for engagement will be called for document verification (DV) in the ratio 1:1 duly following reservation and departmental procedure. Date/time & place of Document verification will be intimated once the application received are screened as per instructions in force. Candidates who are called for DV have to attend the medical examination. As per extant Board guidelines interview as part of selection process has been eliminated. In order to bring in greater transparency, uniformity in selection and to reduce subjectivity, there shall-not be any process of interview in the selection of Junior Technical Associates.



8. How to apply:-

Candidate will apply for the notified posts as per their eligibility, through ONLINE application mode by visiting the website WWW.swrmyscontract.com duly uploading the self attested copies of certificates in support of their i) Educational Qualification ii) Proof of Date of Birth iii) Identity proof iv) Certificate in support of SC/ST/OBC

10. Terms and conditions:-

1. The engagement of the above Junior Technical Associates would be on full time contract basis for a period up to 30.11.2020 or till regularly selected RRB candidates are available or till the currency of the scheme exists, whichever is the earliest.
2. **The service of these Junior Technical Associates is also terminable before the expiry of the contract period, on un-satisfactory performance.** Their services rendered as contract Junior Technical Associates is a stop-gap arrangement and will not have any bearing in respect of consideration of their period of service in case of regular selection through Railway Recruitment Board. This contract engagement will also not confer any right to regularization or absorption
3. The minimum working hour 12 hours per day that may include day/night or day-cum-night as per exigency of service. The rest/weekly off may be on different days, not necessarily on holidays & Sunday etc.
4. All the candidates proposed to be engaged should have good physical and mental health as per Railway Medical standards and they will be subjected to medical examination and should be found fit in medical classification mentioned against the post they apply.
5. The selected Candidates must bring the following original documents along with one attested copy of the documents at the time document verification.
 - a. Date of birth certificate or SSLC/SSE Board Certificate.
 - b. All Education certificates (eg SSLC/SSC, HSC, Diploma/Degree etc)
 - c. If working NOC from the current employer
 - d. SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if belongs to SC/ST/OBC.
 - e. Academic/Educational Qualification for every category must be from a recognized Institution/Board (Mark Sheet and Certificate)
6. In case of unsatisfactory work or misconduct on part of the personnel so engaged on contract basis. Railway reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reasons thereof.
7. The contract Junior Technical Associates shall not be entitled for Railway Quarters etc., as a matter of right. However, if available, they will be provided accommodation. If government accommodation is provided, an amount equivalent to the sum of HRA plus license fee of the accommodation so provided will be deducted.

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
8. The contract will be ceased on completion of the period up to 30.11.2020 automatically without issue of any notice etc or joining of regular candidates whichever is earlier.
9. **No private Employment or any other employment will be permitted during the subsistence of the contract period.**
10. The detailed contract agreement will have to be executed by the candidates on their successful selection.
11. The detailed instructions with regard to duties while in contract with Railway shall be given to the candidates in the event of selection and subsequent signing of contract agreement.
12. During the validity of the contract, the candidate will be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his/her career or any other grounds by giving prior 30 days notice to the Railways.
13. The service of the candidates are also terminable before the expiry of the given period by either side after giving 30 days notice or on payment of 30 days of remuneration in lieu of the same
14. The selected candidates will be governed by the instructions issued by the Railway Ministry/ Railway Administration for grant of leave and other privileges etc.
15. The Administration reserve right to deploy the candidates in any area depending upon the exigency of the service and refusal or otherwise will be deemed as misconduct on the part of the candidates.
16. The selected candidate will be paid remuneration as noted in Para-5 mentioned above and the candidates cannot claim any additional remuneration allowances or other benefits during the course of contract period.
17. The candidates are personally responsible for payment of professional tax, income tax and other duties/ taxes leviable by the State/Central Governments from time to time.
18. The Railway Administration reserves right to cancel, amend or otherwise modify all or any of the terms of the notification without assigning any reason there to.
19. The eligible and willing candidates should report to the venue at 9 am on the date of document verification along with the filled up application form in prescribed format appended duly enclosing necessary attested copies of testimonials and producing original certificate for verification and interview.
20. Incomplete applications, applications not containing uploaded semester wise mark sheet, Diploma/Degree certificate will be rejected. Candidates claiming SC/ST/OBC, but not uploaded SC/ST/OBC certificate will be considered against Unreserved vacancies (UR). In the event, Candidates called for document verification on the nominated day but not turned up. In that circumstances candidates below the merit of candidates (not turned up) will be considered for further process of engagement of JTA. The above procedure will be resorted, if the candidates become medical unfit in the prescribed category.



23. Candidates in the ratio of 1:1 (Based on the merit and reservation requirement) who attend the document verification will be empanelled for the vacancies of Mysuru Division only and the candidates should be prepared to serve anywhere on Mysuru Division.
24. The allotment of the post on engagement as Junior Technical Associate is the discretionary power of the Railway Administration.
25. Candidates are advised to keep their personal mobile number and personal valid e-mail ID active throughout the engagement of contract process, as the communications will be sent through SMS/E-Mail/Whatsapp.
26. If the candidates possessing both Diploma and Degree in Civil Engineering, highest qualification will be considered for arriving merit order.
