



Dr R Soundararajan, Principal Chief Medical Director is an officer of Indian Railway Health Services – 1985 batch.

He completed his MBBS from Tanjavur Medical College and did his MS in Orthopedics from prestigious Madras Medical College.

Before joining as PCMD he was Chief Medical Superintendent of Tiruchirappalli where he spearheaded the battle against Covid-19 at Divisional Railway Hospital, Tiruchirappalli. During his tenure many medical equipments such as Digital Radiography machine, C-Arm, Fully automated Hematology analyzer, PSA plant, Ophthalmic Microscope, USG machine, Ventilators, Oxygen Concentrators, HFNO devices, Oxygen cylinders, Dental Chair with X-Ray Unit etc were procured and installed. All 197 beds of the hospital were supplied with piped Oxygen and Tiruchirappalli Divisional Railway Hospital was declared as Dedicated Covid Care Center. Renovation of Gynecology ward was done during his period. Also, Renovation of Operation Theatre costing 1.93 Crores was initiated and is under process.

Prior to this, he was the Chief Medical Superintendent of UBL division. During this period he has conducted Health Camps for the employees in all the health units of UBL division. Also, he was enthusiastically involved in Swachta Abhiyan and encouraged medical staff of Hubli division to take active part in the program.

He has a very rich and vast experience of working in Indian Railways and has worked in various capacities such as ADMO in Dhanbad Divisional Hospital, Eastern Railway, DMO in Erode Sub-Divisional Hospital and Sr.DMO in Tiruchirappalli Divisional hospital before becoming Chief Medical Superintendent/UBL.
