Sub: Application/Options for the posts of Chief Vigilance Inspector/Vigilance Inspector (IT) in Pay Matrix level-7/ level-6 of 7th CPC in the Vigilance department of S.W.Railway/Hubli.

- (I) It is proposed to conduct a selection to fill up (01)One ex-cadre post of Chief Vigilance Inspector in Vigilance Organization /SWR/HQrs as per the details given below by calling for volunteers. Accordingly, applications are invited from eligible staff.

Post	No.of vacancies	Specific eligibility
CVI (Information Technology)	01	Staff of all departments working on regular measure in Level 7 or Level 6 of Pay Matrix, 7 th CPC (not MACP), for post of CVI

CVI/VI (IT)-Educational Qualification:

The candidates should either possess any of the following educational qualification:

- B.Sc. - Bachelor of Science (Computer Science)
- B.C.A - Bachelor of Computer Application.
- B.E/B.Tech (Computer Science /Information Technology/ Electronics/Electrical or equivalent
- Post graduation or higher degree in the above disciplines.

The degree should be from a recognized university.

(II) Method of Selection:

A written examination and a vigilance aptitude and computer knowledge test will be conducted as part of the selection procedure. The distribution of marks for selection is stated below:

Candidates who obtain atleast 60% marks in the written examination will be called for appearing in the Vigilance Aptitude & Computer knowledge test and those who are securing 60% of marks including Record of service in aggregate will be eligible for empanelment.

The written examination will consist of questions on the following:

- Basics of Operating Systems, Programming Languages like C,C++, Python, Java etc., Networking, System Applications, Web Development, Data Analysis, Business Intelligence, Cyber Security and Database Management.
- Writing a self contained report based on analysis of information
- Knowledge of Discipline & Appeal Rules-1968. Railway Service Conduct Rules-1966 and inquiries & ability to marshal facts to write reports.

Answers have to be written in English or Hindi only.

No supplementary written examination will be conducted since the selection is by calling volunteers.

(III) **Terms and Conditions:**

- Volunteers should be working in level-7 of pay matrix of 7th CPC (PB-II Rs. 9300-34800/-, GP Rs. 4600/- on regular basis (not under MACP).
- Volunteers working in level-6 of pay matrix of 7th CPC (PB-II Rs. 9300-34800 + GP.Rs.4200/-) on regular basis are also eligible to apply. However, they should have put in minimum two years of service in that grade on the date of notification.
- The volunteers should have put in minimum 05years continuous service in Railways as on the date of notification.
- They should have flair for vigilance work i.e. in vigilance investigations and other associated works.
- The job requires extensive travelling/physical hardship, irregular duty hours and also some risks. Therefore, volunteers should be willing to work under such condition.
- Those who have worked as served as Chief Vigilance Inspectors in Vigilance organization can apply only after a cooling off period of **two** years.

7. They should be free from DAR/SPE/Vigilance cases and should not have been taken up under DAR as a result of SPE/Vigilance cases during their entire period of service. They should have good record of service with proven integrity.
8. Vigilance is an ex-cadre organization. Therefore, staff selected for posting in the vigilance department will continue to maintain their lien and seniority in their parent department/cadre.
9. Volunteers who are applying in response to this notification should note that they are required to join immediately and refusal to join the relevant post will not be agreed to and the same will be viewed seriously.
10. Though the normal tenure of Vigilance Inspector is 03years which may be extended for 2years depending upon the individual performance and integrity. The Railway Administration has a right to repatriate the person at any time without assigning any reason, even if he has not completed initial period of tenure or extension, if any, granted thereto.
11. Applications should be submitted in the proforma enclosed complete in all respects and duly signed by the applicant and the respective controlling officer.
12. Applications should be submitted through proper channel and after obtaining necessary approvals.
13. The last date for the candidates to submit their application to their supervisory officials is **05.12.2024.**
14. **The applications along with last three years of APARS with grading Very Good and above only to be forwarded to this office on or before 13.12.2024 by cadre controlling authority.**
15. Applications received in this office after the stipulated date will not be entertained.
- 16 **Candidates should treat this notification as an alert notice, and should be in readiness to appear for the written examination at short notice.**
If there are no applications, NIL report may be sent positively.
