(I) It is proposed to conduct a selection to fill up (01)One ex-cadre post of Chief Vigilance Inspector in Vigilance Organization /SWR/HQrs as per the details given below by calling for volunteers. Accordingly, applications are invited from eligible staff.

1	Information Technology	01	Staff of all departments working on regular measure in Level 7 or Level 6 of Pay Matrix, 7 <sup>th</sup> CPC (not MACP) or one grade below, for post of CVI and VI respectively.  Staff working in Level 8 Pay matrix are also eligible to apply for the post. However, the staff selected for the post of CVI will be transferred to Vigilance branch along with the post of Level 8 and the element of post in Level 7 in Vigilance office will be transferred to the lien unit if needed.

# CVI/VI (IT)-Educational Qualification:

The candidates should either possess any of the following educational qualification:

- B.Sc. Bachelor of Science (Computer Science)
- B.C.A Bachelor of Computer Application.
- B.E/B.Tech (Computer Science /Information Technology/ Electronics/Electrical or equivalent
- Post graduation or higher degree in the above disciplines.

The degree should be from a recognized university.

#### (II) Method of Selection:

A written examination and a vigilance aptitude and computer knowledge test will be conducted as part of the selection procedure. The distribution of marks for selection is stated below:

Candidates who obtain atleast 60% marks in the written examination will be called for appearing in the Vigilance Aptitude & Computer knowledge test and those who are securing 60% of marks including Record of service in aggregate will be eligible for empanellement.

The written examination will consist of questions on the following:

- a. Basics of Operating Systems, Programming Languages like C,C++, Python, Java etc., Networking, System Applications, Web Development, Data Analysis, Business Intelligence, Cyber Security and Database Management.
- b. Writing a self contained report based on analysis of information

Answers have to be written in English or Hindi only.

No supplementary written examination will be conducted since the selection is by calling volunteers.

## Terms and Conditions:

- a. They should not have worked as Vigilance Inspector / Investigating Inspector earlier for a tenure in Vigilance branch / Vigilance Directorate.
- b. Those who have worked as Chief Enquiry Inspectors in Vigilance organization can apply for the post of CVIs only after a cooling off period of **two** years.
- c. They should be free from DAR/SPE/Vigilance cases and should not have been taken up under DAR as a result of SPE/Vigilance cases during their entire period of service. They should have a good record of service with proven integrity.
- d. Application of only those who can be spared on their selection, may be forwarded. It may be noted that it will be compulsory to relieve the employee after selection.
- e. Vigilance is an ex-cadre organization. Therefore, staff selected for posting in the vigilance department will continue to maintain their lien and seniority in their parent department/cadre.
- f. Though the normal tenure of Vigilance Inspector is four years, continuance as Vigilance Inspector depends upon the individual performance and integrity. They are liable to be repatriated to their parent department at any time short of completion of tenure without assigning any reason.
- g. Applications should be submitted in the proforma enclosed complete in all respects and duly signed by the applicant and the respective controlling officer.
- h. Applications should be submitted through proper channel after obtaining necessary approvals.

- i. The last date for the candidates to submit their application to their supervisory officials is **30.04.2025**.

- 1. Candidates should treat this notification as an alert notice, and should be in readiness to appear for the written examination at short notice.
