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Terms and conditions

Ref: Public Auction Sale Notification No. B/C.206/Auction/Fly Ash/SGWF/2025 dated 12.08.2025

It is proposed to conduct a Public Auction Sale at Satellite Goods Terminal Whitefield (SGWF) at 12.30 hrs on 05.09.2025, of approximate 64 Tons of Flyash unloaded from unconnected wagon no. ECOR BOXNHL 22121334864, subject to the following Terms and Conditions.

- 1. The Public Auction Sale will be conducted at Satellite Goods Terminal Whitefield, SGWF Goods shed on 05.09.2025 at 12.30 Hrs.
- 2. The Auction Sale of Flyash will be conducted on "As is, where is" basis.
- 3. The approximate quantity of Fly Ash for auction sale is 64 Tons.
- 4. The Fly Ash samples were tested in Laboratory and the result was found within the Parameters.
- 5. Minimum Reserve Price (MRP) is fixed in terms of rate per one Kilogram. The highest bidder offering the rate above the MRP will be the successful bidder.
- 6. Each bidder should keep a Security Deposit of Rs.10,000/- in cash/Demand Draft with the Auctioning Officer before the commencement of the Auction proceedings. This amount will be adjusted against the Auction Sale amount payable by the successful bidder and will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders.
- 7. Apart from the bided amount, the successful bidder will have to pay GST at the applicable rate in force as on the day of auctioning. At present, the rate of GST applicable for Auction sale is 5%.
- 8. After the bidding is over, the successful bidder will have to arrange for weighment of the material at a weighbridge nearest to SGWF. The weighment of empty trucks and the loaded trucks shall be done in the presence of the successful bidder and Railway Officials. The truck hire charges, loading charges, transportation charges, weighment charges etc. will have to be borne by the successful bidder.
- 9. The Auction sale amount worked out after the Auction process should be paid before 17.00 hrs of the day of auction in the form of Cash or DD drawn in favor of FA & CAO/ South Western Railway, Payable at Bangalore.
- 10. Balance amount if any, arrived at as per the weighment, should be paid before 17.00 hrs of the day of Weighment. The Weighment should complete before 17.00 hrs of the day following the day of auction.
 - 11.Only after payment of all the due charges, the possession of the auctioned material will be handed over to the successful bidder. The maximum time limit to make payment of all the due charges and to remove the material is up to 17.00 Hrs of the day following the day of auction.
